

In Person Services Arrangements

Before you arrive

Assess your own circumstances as to whether you should come.

If you or anyone in your household has symptoms or have been in contact with someone who does, please do not attend church.

If you are clinically vulnerable you should not attend

B.Y.O.R – Bring Your Own Refreshments for you and your household to have during the service if you wish (e.g. water or hot drinks) as the kitchen will be out of use.

B.Y.O.B – Bring Your Own Bible, as there will not be any church bibles available to use.

Book for you and your household using the online booking form, ideally by Saturday evening.

As you arrive

Sign in at the entrance and wash your hands with the sanitiser provided.

Love others, **by keeping left as you move around the church**, and strictly **keeping to the 2m distance**.

You will be directed to your seat by the steward.

Keep conversation to a low level – **please remain in your seats**

Remain in your household

If you are late your space may be given to someone else

Masks are mandatory whilst in the building, unless exempt or aged 11 and under.

Please do not mingle or interact with others whilst at the service

During the Service

The service leader will explain how the service will run.

In an emergency use all available exits.

During the service, our sung worship will be led by our own music group, we will read the bible, pray, and listen to God's word preached.

We will not be singing congregationally - you can hum or quietly reflect on the words

If you develop COVID-19 symptoms during the service, please leave straightaway and inform a steward on the way out.

Sadly, we are not able to provide a creche, but space will be available in the hall for you to use during service.

Toilets will be open, with one person in at a time.

When seated please leave at **least three seats** between you and another household

After the service

Unfortunately, we will not be serving refreshments after the service.

Please remain in your seats until directed to leave by the stewards

Please leave the service promptly, keeping left and maintaining 2m distance.

Please do not gather and stop for conversation after the service indoors/outdoors.

As you leave please use the hand wash stations available at the exits.

There will be two exits available, please follow signage

Offering, plates will be available at the exits for you to put your offerings in.
